INLAND FISHERIES ACTS 1959-2010

NO. 11 OR BALLINA DISTRICT
(PROHIBITION ON ANGLING WITH ROD AND LINE)
BYE-LAW NO. C.S. 895, 2012

I, Fergus O'Dowd, Minister of State at the Department of Communications, Energy and Natural Resources, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 57 of the Inland Fisheries Act 2010 (No. 10 of 2010) and the Energy and Natural Resources (Delegation of Ministerial Functions) (No. 2) Order 2011 (S.I. No. 631 of 2011), at the request of Inland Fisheries Ireland, and having complied with Regulations 27 and 42 of the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) Regulations 2011 (S.I. No. 477 of 2011), hereby make the following bye-law:

1. This Bye-law may be cited as the No. 11 or Ballina District (Prohibition on Angling with Rod and Line) Bye-law No. C.S. 895, 2012.

2. This Bye-law comes into operation on 1 February 2012.

3. Notwithstanding anything contained in any other Bye-law, angling with rod and line is prohibited in the waters described in Article 4 (2) during the period commencing 1 February and ending on 31 May in each of the years 2012, 2013 and 2014, respectively.

4. (1) In this Article a reference to—

(a) a marker is a reference to a coloured marker fixed in or adjacent to the waters mentioned in paragraph (2) and referred to in a map, and

(b) a map is a reference to a map attached to this Bye-law.

(2) The waters referred to in Article 3 are:

(a) that portion of Lough Conn and Lough Cullin defined as being south of a line drawn from a point in the townland of Cuingmore on the shore of Lough Conn indicated by a blue and white marker (referred to at point A on map 1), running in a south westerly direction to a point in the townland of Laughil on the shore of Lough Conn, indicated by a yellow and white marker (referred to at point B on map 1) and north of a line drawn from a point in the townland of Cuingmore on the shore of Lough Cullin, indicated by a green and white marker (referred to at point C on map 1) running in a south westerly direction to a point in the townland of Laughil on the shore of Lough Cullin, indicated by a red and white marker (referred to at point D on map 1),

(b) that portion of the River Deel and Lough Conn defined as being from the downstream face of Knockadangan Bridge to east of a line drawn from a point in the townland of Wherrew, indicated by a red and white marker (referred to at point A on map 2), running in a northerly direction to a point

in the townland of Grange, indicated by a blue and white marker (referred to at point B on map 2), and

(c) that portion of water from the westward face of the railway bridge that spans the outflowing river from Lough Cullin to the River Moy to east of a line drawn from a point in the townland of Corummin on the shore of Lough Cullin, indicated by a red and white marker (referred to at point A on map 3), running in a south easterly direction to a point in the townland of Pollagh on the shore of Lough Cullin, indicated by a blue and white marker (referred to at point B on map 3), in the No. 11 or Ballina District.

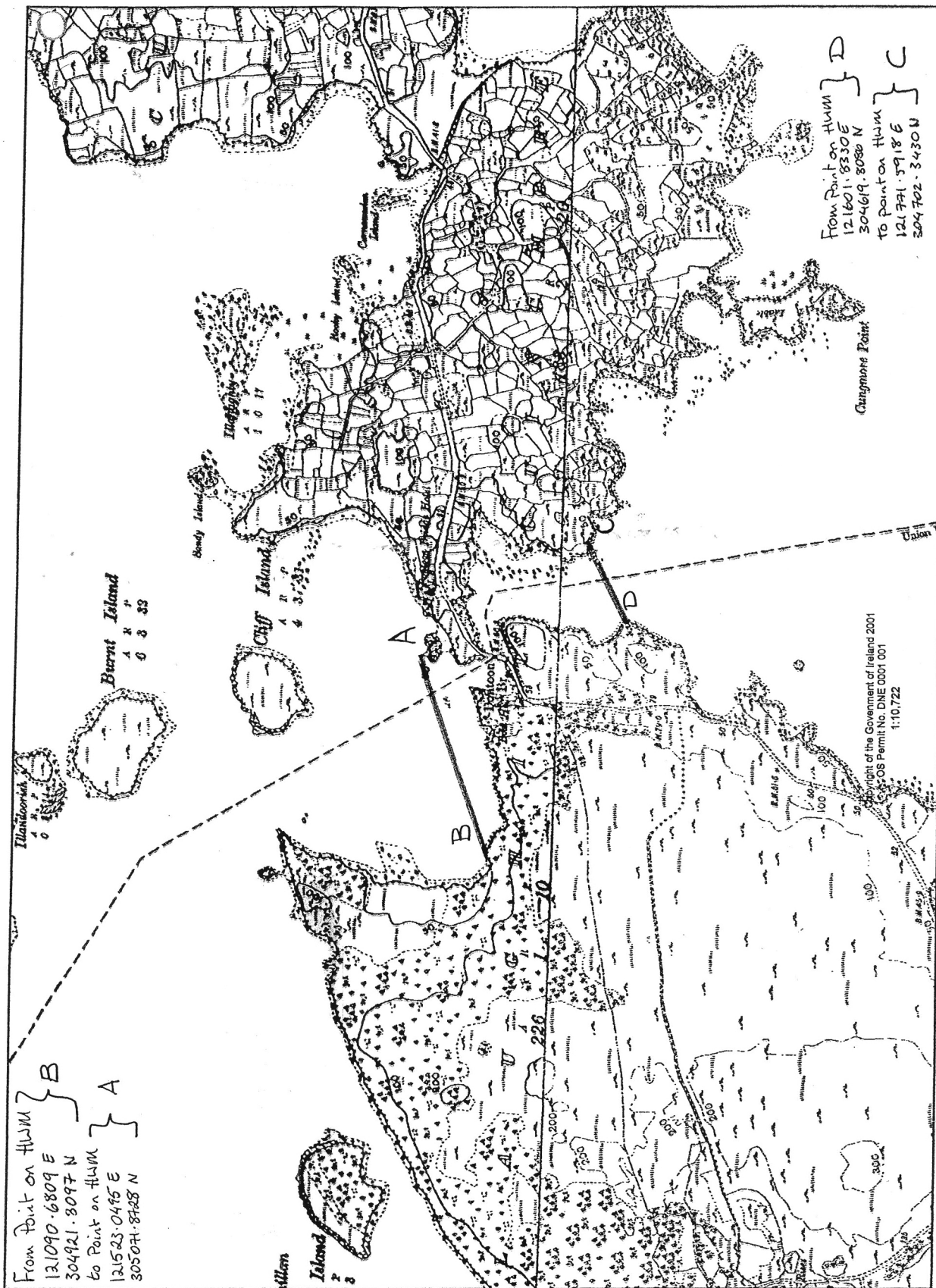

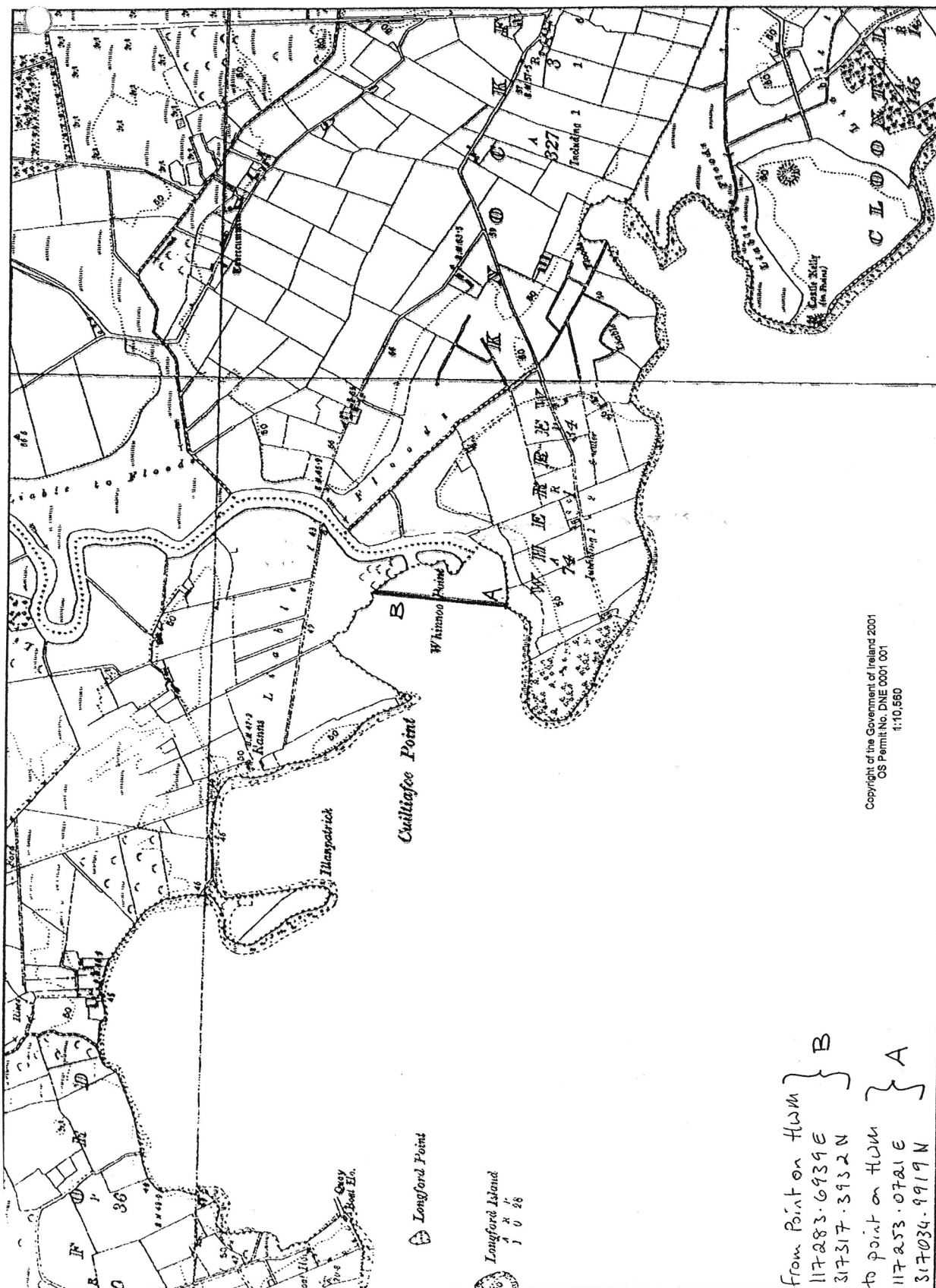
This Bye-Law provides for an extension to the annual close season for angling with rod and line in parts of Lough Conn, Lough Cullin and River Deel from 1 February to 31 May (both dates inclusive) in each of the years 2012, 2013 and 2014.

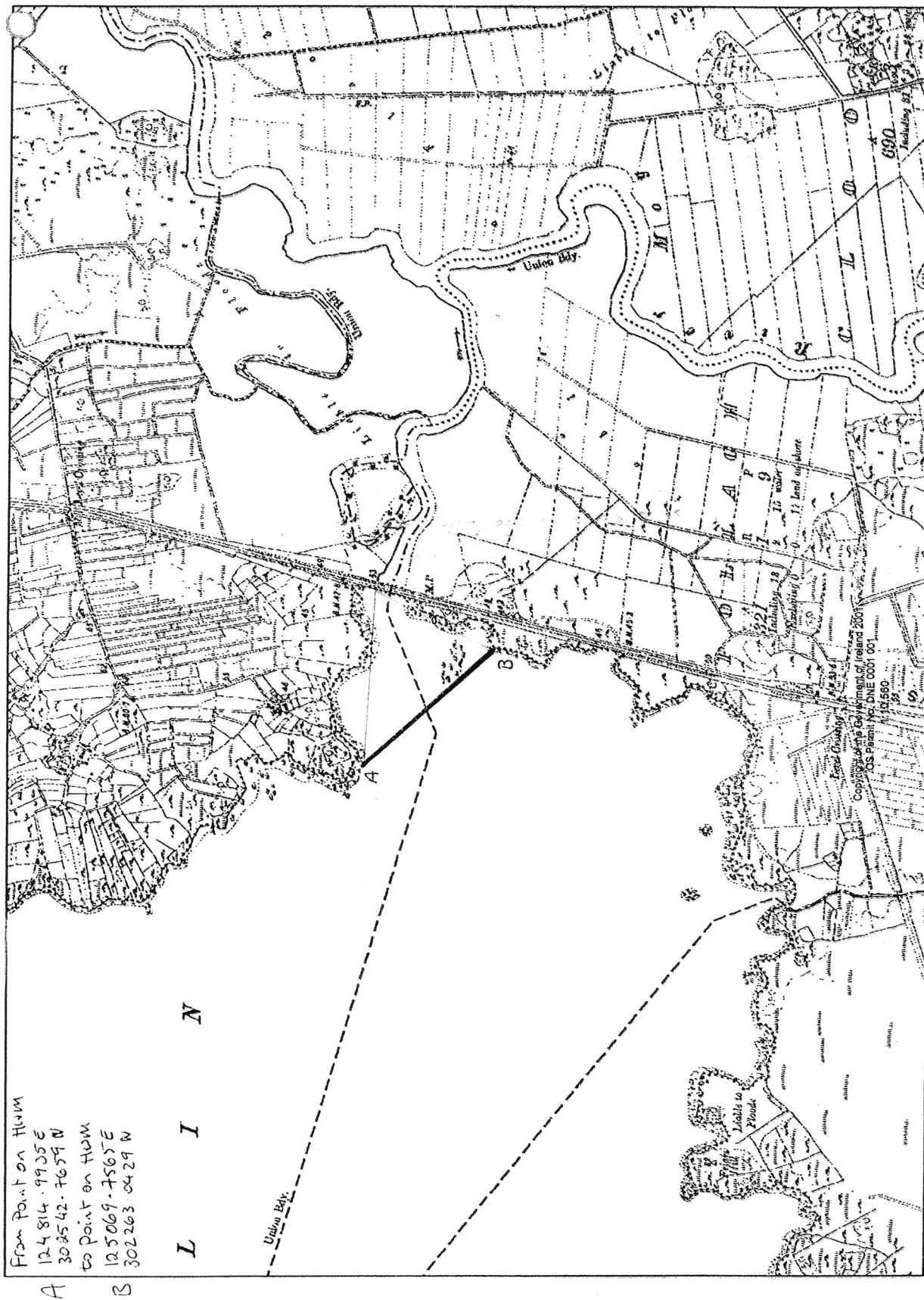
FOOTNOTE

Section 57 (7) of the Inland Fisheries Act, 2010 provides that any person aggrieved by this Bye-law may within 28 days after its publication in the *Iris Oifigiúil*, appeal against same to the High Court.

DETERMINATION (NO. 18) OF THE NEED FOR AN AUTHORISATION FOR CERTAIN FISH STOCKS

I, Simon Coveney, Minister for Agriculture, Food and the Marine, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 13(15) of the Sea-Fisheries and Maritime Jurisdiction Act 2006 (No. 8 of 2006) (“Act”) and the Sea Fisheries, Foreshore and Dumping at Sea (Transfer of Departmental Administration and Ministerial Functions) Order 2007 (S.I. No. 707 of 2007) (as adapted by the Agriculture and Food (Alteration of Name of Department and Title of Minister) Order 2011 (S.I. No. 455 of 2011)), determine:

1. This determination may be referred to as Determination (No. 18) of the Need for an Authorisation for Certain Fish Stocks.

2. An authorisation, granted under section 13(1) of the Act, is required by an Irish sea-fishing boat of a type specified in column (3) of the Schedule to fish for, retain on board, trans-ship or land from that boat the fish stock, or group of fish stocks, specified in column (2) of the Schedule opposite the reference to the type of boat.

3. In the Schedule, the ICES sub-areas and divisions mentioned in column (2) refer to the waters falling within those ICES sub-areas and divisions as defined in Regulation (EEC) No. 3880/91 of 17 December 1991¹.

4. This Determination revokes and replaces the Determination (No. 17) of the Need for an Authorisation for Certain Fish Stocks, which came into effect on 5 August 2011.

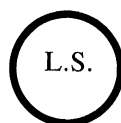
