EUROPEAN UNION (AIR TRAFFIC FLOW

- To Designate the Irish Aviation Authority as the Central Unit within the State for the purposes of implementing new EU Common Rules on Air Traffic Flow Management (ATFM) laid down in Commission Regulation (EU) No. 255/2010, and
- To make Provisions for penalties in respect of infringement of these Rules.

ATFM is the Regulation of Air Traffic in order to avoid exceeding airport or air traffic control capacity in handling traffic.

The amendments include updating standards EN 228 and EN 590 with regard to the testing of petrol and diesel.
