These Regulations give effect to Council Directive No. 92/66/EEC of 14 July, 1992 (as amended by Council Regulation No. (EC) No. 806/2003 of 14 April, 2003, Council Directive No. 2006/104/EC of 20 November, 2006 and Council Directive No. 2008/73/EC of 15 July, 2008) introducing Community measures for the control of Newcastle Disease and for the application of control measures in the event of an outbreak of the disease. EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (VEHICLE TESTING)  
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2012.

These Regulations amend the European Communities (Vehicle Testing) Regulations 2004 (S.I. No. 771 of 2004) for the purposes of:

- including provision for the mandatory testing, from 1 March, 2012, of motor caravans;
- reflecting the replacing of Council Directive 96/96/EC of 20 December, 1996, by Directive 2009/40/EC of the European Parliament and the Council of 6 May, 2009, as amended by Commission Directive 2010/48/EU of 5 July, 2010; and
- reflecting the change in the title of the relevant Minister.

These Regulations also amend the Road Traffic (Construction, Equipment and Use of Vehicles) (Amendment) Regulations 2000 (S.I. No. 224 of 2000) in respect of their application to passenger vehicles having accommodation for more than eight passengers exclusive of the driver, having a design gross vehicle weight not exceeding 5,000 kilograms.

These Regulations revoke the European Communities (Vehicle Testing) (Amendment) Regulations 2007 (S.I. No. 709 of 2007) and the European Communities (Vehicle Testing) (Amendment) Regulations 2011 (S.I. No. 710 of 2011).

## EUROPEAN UNION (COPYRIGHT AND RELATED RIGHTS) REGULATIONS 2012

The Minister for Jobs, Enterprise and Innovation, Mr. Richard Bruton, T.D., in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 3 of the European Communities Act 1972 (No. 27 of 1972) and for the purpose of giving further effect to Directive 2001/29/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 22 May, 2001, has made Regulations, entitled as above.

These Regulations clarify that an injunction may be sought against an intermediary to whom Article 8(3) of Directive 2001/29/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 22 May 2001 on the harmonisation of certain aspects of copyright and related rights in the information society applies. Article 8(3) requires that Rightholders are in a position to apply for an injunction against intermediaries whose services are used by a third party to infringe a copyright or related right.
