## **BUILDING REGULATIONS (PART A AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2012.**

These Regulations amend Part A (Structure) of the Second Schedule to the Building Regulations 1997-2011 and may be cited as the Building Regulations (Part A Amendment) Regulations 2012.

They are necessary to ensure consistency with the Eurocodes, a set of harmonised structural design codes for building and civil engineering works which are now generally in force across EU Member States.

These Regulations shall come into operation on 1 July, 2013.

## **EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (CONSERVATION OF WILD BIRDS (MAGHAREE ISLANDS SPECIAL PROTECTION AREA 004125)) REGULATIONS 2012.**

The purpose of these Regulations is to give further effect to Directive 2009/147/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 30 November 2009 (The Birds Directive) and to Council Directive No. 92/43/EEC of 21 June, 1992 (The Habitats Directive).

The Birds Directive provides for the conservation of wild birds by, among other things, classifying important ornithological sites as Special Protection Areas. The effect of these Regulations is to classify sites as Special Protection Areas in accordance with Article 4 of the Directive and to provide that contravention of the provisions of these Regulations shall constitute an offence.
