EUROPEAN UNION (TEXTILE FIBRE NAMES AND RELATED LABELLING AND MARKING OF THE FIBRE COMPOSITION OF TEXTILE PRODUCTS) REGULATIONS 2012.

The Minister for Jobs, Enterprise and Innovation, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by Section 3 of the European Communities Act 1972 (No. 27 of 1972) has made the following Statutory Instrument: European Union (Textile Fibre Names and Related Labelling and Marking of the Fibre Composition of Textile Products) Regulations 2012 (S.I. No. 142 of 2012). The Regulations come into effect from 8 May, 2012.

These Regulations were made to give effect to Regulation (EU) No. 1007/2011 of the European Parliament and the Council of 27 September, 2011, as amended by Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) No. 286/2012, which ensures that consumer interests are protected by laying down rules governing the labelling or marking of products as regards their textile fibre content and provides uniform methods for quantitative analysis of binary textile fibre mixtures. Textile products may be made available on the market within the EU only if they comply with the provisions of the Regulation.

These Regulations provide for the enforcement of the Regulation and for penalties for contravening the Regulation. The National Consumer Agency will enforce these Regulations.

CONSUMER PROTECTION (CONSUMER INFORMATION) (ARTICLES OF PRECIOUS METALS) REGULATIONS 2012.

The Minister for Jobs, Enterprise and Innovation, Richard Bruton, T.D., in exercise of the powers conferred on him by Section 50 of the Consumer Protection Act 2007 (No. 19 of 2007) (as adapted by the Enterprise, Trade and Innovation (Alteration of Name of Department and Title of Minister) Order 2011 (S.I. No. 245 of 2011) has made the following Statutory Instrument: Consumer Protection (Consumer Information) (Articles of Precious Metals) Regulations 2012.

The Regulations come into effect from 1 July, 2012.

These Regulations were made to provide consumers with information on articles made from precious metals and for the purpose of designating the National Consumer Agency as the authority responsible for the enforcement of hallmarking legislation. Hallmarking describes the administrative and legal system for ensuring that articles of precious metals conform to legal standards as to the fineness of the precious metals.

These Regulations require traders, selling articles made from precious metals (gold, silver or platinum), to ensure that they have an approved hallmark and the trader must display a notice prescribing the hallmarks allowed and showing examples of these hallmarks.
