The effect of these Regulations is to provide for penalties for infringements of the provisions of Regulation (EC) No. 765/2006 concerning restrictive measures against President Lukashenko and certain officials of Belarus, as amended by Council Regulation (EU) No. 588/2011. Council Regulation (EU) No. 588/2011 imposes an arms embargo and a ban on equipment which might be used for internal repression.
