WASTE WATER DISCHARGE (AUTHORISATION)  
(ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT)

The Minister for Housing, Planning, Community and Local Government has made the above Regulations.

The purpose of these Regulations is to give further effect in Irish law to Articles 2 to 4 of Directive 2011/92/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 13 December 2011 on the assessment of the effects of certain public and private projects on the environment.

The Regulations provide that where an application is made to the Environmental Protection Agency for a waste water discharge licence or for the review of a waste water discharge licence in a case where there is no requirement for physical development, that the Agency must carry out screening for environmental impact assessment before granting any licence and may carry out an environmental impact assessment if it deems it appropriate.

An amendment is also made to the Waste Water Discharge (Authorisation) Regulations 2907 (No. 684 of 2007) placing an onus on a planning authority and An Bord Pleanála to consult the Agency where the authority or the Board considers that a proposed development is likely to have a significant impact on waste water discharges.

Further amendments to the 2007 Regulations update the cross-referencing to the Planning and Development Act 2000 (No. 30 of 2000), reflecting amendments to that Act.

1. (1) This Bye-law may be cited as the Angling Bye-law No. 943, 2016.

(2) This Bye-law comes into operation on 1 January 2017.

Notwithstanding anything contained in any Bye-law, it is prohibited for a person to use, or attempt to use, worms as bait or to use, or attempt to use, any fish hooks, other than single barbless hooks, in angling for any kind of fish in the waters of a river mentioned in column (2) of the Schedule opposite the mention of a fishery district in column (1) of that Schedule.

1. (1) This Bye-law may be cited as the Conservation of Salmon and Sea Trout (Catch and Release) Bye-law No. 945, 2016.

(2) This Bye-law comes into operation on 1 January 2017.

2. In this Bye-law -

“catch and release” in relation to angling for salmon and sea trout in the waters of the rivers to which this Bye-law applies, means carefully handling any fish caught and immediately returning the fish alive to the waters;

“fish” means salmon, sea trout or a combination of both;

“salmon” means fish of the species *Salmo salar* (Atlantic salmon);

“sea trout” means fish of the migratory form of *Salmo trutta*, but does not include a sea trout which is 40 centimetres or less in length measured in a straight line from the tip of the snout to the fork of the tail.

3. Notwithstanding anything contained in any Bye-law, it is prohibited for a person, in a river mentioned in column (2) of the Schedule opposite mention of a fishery district in column (1) of the Schedule, to -

(a) take by rod and line any salmon or sea trout from the waters of the river, other than by catch and release, or

(b) use or attempt to use -

(i) worms as bait, or

(ii) any fish hooks other than single barbless hooks,

in angling for salmon or sea trout in the waters of the river.

4. The Conservation of Salmon and Sea Trout (Catch and Release) Bye-law No. 935, 2015 is revoked.

3. Subject to the prohibitions contained in Angling Bye-Law No. 943, 2016 and the Conservation of Sea Trout Bye-law No. 834, 2008 a person shall not take by rod and line from the waters of a river in any fishery district more than 3 sea trout on any day in any year.

4. It is prohibited for a person where he or she has taken the number of sea trout permitted under Article 3 to -

- (a) take by rod and line any sea trout from the waters of a river in any fishery district, other than by catch and release, or
- (b) use or attempt to use worms as bait or any fish hooks, other than single barbless hooks, in angling for sea trout in the waters of a river in any fishery district.

5. The Conservation of Sea Trout Bye-Law No. 937, 2015 is revoked.

“fish” mean either salmon or sea trout or a combination of both;

“salmon” means fish of the species *Salmo salar* (Atlantic salmon);

“sea trout” means fish of the migratory form of *Salmo trutta*, but does not include a sea trout which is 40 centimetres or less in length measured in a straight line from the tip of the snout to the fork of the tail.

3. Notwithstanding anything contained in any Bye-law prohibiting the taking or having possession of more than a specified number of salmon or sea trout, a person shall not take by rod and line more than 10 fish in any year.

4. Subject to Article 5, it is prohibited for a person to take by rod and line -

(a) during any year from 1 January to 11 May, more than 3 fish, but not more than 1 fish on any day during that period, and

(b) on any day in any year -

(i) from 12 May to 31 August, more than 3 fish, and

(ii) from 1 September to the beginning of the close season, more than 1 fish.

5. It is prohibited for a person, in a river mentioned in column (2) of the Schedule opposite mention of a fishery district in column (1) of the Schedule, where he or she has taken the number of fish permitted under Article 3 or 4, to -

(a) take by rod and line any fish from the waters of the river, other than by catch and release, or

(b) use or attempt to use worms as bait or any fish hooks, other than single barbless hooks, in angling for fish in the waters of the river.

6. The Conservation of Salmon and Sea Trout (Bag Limits) Bye-law No. 934, 2015 is revoked.
