**Revised Terms of Reference following submission of the Second
Interim Report by the Commission**

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6(1) of the Commissions of Investigation Act 2004, the amended Terms of Reference of this Commission of Investigation which were published in Irish Oifigiúil on 30 June 2015 are further amended by the deletion of "**20 November 2015**" and the insertion of "**31 May 2016**".

Revised Statement of Costs and Time Frame for Investigation

A notice published in Iris Oifigiúil on 30 June 2015 indicated that the Minister for Justice and Equality had agreed to a revised date of 20 November 2015 for the MacLochlainn Commission of Investigation to submit its final report. The notice also amended Commission's the terms of reference to reflect this position. In the context of the Commission requiring an additional six months to report, revised costs for the Commission, excluding third party costs, were estimated to be €627,500.

The Commission has now requested a further extension to 31 May 2016 to complete its work and to present its final report. The Minister for Justice and Equality has granted this further extension to the Commission. This extension is estimated to increase the costs of the Commission to €850,000. This figure does not include third party costs which are to be determined by the Commission in accordance with the *General Guidelines and Payment of Legal Costs and Other Expenses to Witnesses and the Payment of Expenses to other Persons who Attend before the Commission* prepared for the Commission as required by the Commissions of Investigation Act 2004.

1. Turn Key Outlets Limited (hereinafter called "the Company") was incorporated in the State pursuant to the provisions of the Companies Acts 1963 to 2013 on the 5th May, 2010 having been incorporated prior to the commencement of the Companies Act, 2014.

2. The registered office of the Company is 31 Glen Dara, Kilteragh, Dooradoyle, County Limerick.

3. The nominal share capital of the Company is €100 divided into 100 shares at €1 each. The amount of capital paid up or credited as paid up is €100.

4. The objects for which the company was established are:

(a) To carry on the business of a restaurant, café bar, delicatessen, bistro, diner, takeaway restaurant, licensed premises for alcoholic beverages, holders of a seven-day licence, wine bar, caterers and anything ancillary to the above.

and such other objects as set forth in the Memorandum of Association thereof.

5. The Directors of the Company are Thomas O'Sullivan of 31 Glendara, Kilteragh, Dooradoyle, County Limerick and Kenneth Dunne of 2 Hillside Ferndale, Ennis Road, County Limerick. Mr. Thomas O'Sullivan is also the Company Secretary.

6. Council Regulation (EC) No 1346/2000 applies to the proceedings. The centre of main interests (determined in accordance with Council Regulation (EC) No 1346/2000) of the company is situated in the State because said company is a company incorporated within the State, has its registered office in the State and further carries on its business from leased bar and restaurant premises located within the State.

7. To your petitioners' knowledge, no insolvency proceedings have been opened in respect of the company in a Member State of the European Union to which Council Regulation (EC) No 1346/2000 applies.

8. All necessary inquiries having been made by your petitioners, the company has no obligations in relation to a bank asset that has been transferred to the National Asset Management Agency (NAMA) or a NAMA group entity (each within the meaning of the National Asset Management Agency Act 2009).

9. Your Petitioners are the Joint Receivers over the assets of Kevin Burke and William O'Meara. The Receivers were appointed by way of Deed of Appointment executed on the 1st June, 2012.

10. The Company is indebted to your Petitioners in the sum of €57,833.95 arising from a lease entered into between 8th September, 2010 between William O'Meara and Kevin Burke and the Respondent herein relating the Respondent's rental of the premises known as the Hi Way Bar and Restaurant comprised in Folio 26764 of County Limerick. The lease was for a two year period from the 1st July, 2010 and the annual rent was €70,000.

11. On the 19th February 2015 Solicitors on behalf of the Petitioners, McEvoy Partners of Hatch Street, Dublin 2, served on the Company at its registered office, being 31 Glen Dara, Kilteragh, Dooradoyle, County Limerick, a letter of demand calling on the Company to pay the sum of €77,833.95 in accordance with Sections 213 and 214 of the Companies Act, 1963, as amended.

12. It came to your Petitioner's attention, subsequent to the service of the aforementioned letter of the 19th February 2015 that monies received from the Company in 2014 in the sum of €20,000 and received as mesne rates had not been factored into the figure stated as outstanding in the Petitioner's letter of the 19th February 2015.
13. On the 7th May 2015 Solicitors on behalf of the Petitioners served on the Company at its registered office an amended letter of demand calling on the Company to pay the sum of €57,833.95 (being the amount owed in light of the €20,000 correction) in accordance with Sections 213 & 214 of the Companies Act, 1963, as amended. 15. At the time of presentation of this Petition, the Company is indebted to your Petitioners in the sum of €57,833.95 plus interest pursuant to Special Condition 16 of the lease in question.
16. In the premises, your Petitioners are satisfied that the Company is insolvent and unable to pay its debts. In the circumstances, it is just and equitable that the Company should be wound up.

Your Petitioners therefore pray:

- i. That Turn Key Outlets Limited be wound up by this Honourable Court on the ground that it is unable to pay its debts within the meaning of Section 570 and should be wound up pursuant to the provisions of Section 569(d) and Section 571 of the Companies Act, 2014.
- ii. In the alternative, that such other Orders may be made by this Honourable Court on this Petition as may appear proper, including some or all of the following:
 - (a) That Mr. Sean McNamara of Smith Williamson Accountants be appointed Official Liquidator of the Company.
