Interim Report by the Commission**

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6(1) of the Commissions of Investigation Act 2004, the amended Terms of Reference of this Commission of Investigation which were published in Irish Oifigiúil on 20 November 2016 are further amended by the deletion of "make a report on or before 31 May 2016" and the insertion after "2004" and before "on" of "make a report within one month of the perfection of the final order arising from proceedings commenced on 16th May 2016 pursuant to section 35(1)(b) of the Act,".

Revised Statement of Costs and Time Frame for Investigation

A notice published in Iris Oifigiúil on 20 November 2016 indicated that the Minister for Justice and Equality had agreed to a revised date of 31 May 2016 for the MacLochlainn Commission of Investigation to submit its final report. The notice also amended the Commission's terms of reference to reflect this position.

The Sole Member of the Commission has advised the Minister that a further extension is required as one of the parties named in the Commission's report has made an application to the High Court under section 35(1)(b) of the Commissions of Investigation Act 2004 for an order directing that the Commission's report be amended before its submission to the specified Minister. Arising from this application, the Commission is unable to meet the 31 May 2016 reporting deadline and the Minister has granted the extension which the Commission requested. The Commission is now required to report within one month of the finalisation of the legal proceedings on the application.

As it is not clear what further costs will arise for the Commission, the Department has not sought an increase in the budget of €850,000 which has been sanctioned for this Commission, exclusive of third party costs.

SAFETY, HEALTH AND WELFARE AT WORK (GENERAL APPLICATION) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2016.

These Regulations amend the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work (General Application) Regulations 2007 to 2012 by inserting a new Part 11 (Woodworking Machines), Part 12 (Abrasive Wheels) and Part 13 (Abrasive Blasting of Surfaces) as well as inserting Schedule 13 (Woodworking Machines) and Schedule 14 (Training and Instruction) to the Regulations.

The collective Regulations shall be cited together as the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work (General Application) Regulations 2007 to 2016.

The Regulations revoke and replace 3 individual sets of Regulations—

- (a) Factories (Woodworking Machinery) Regulations, 1972. (S.I. No. 203 of 1972),
- (b) Factories (Abrasive Blasting of Surfaces) Regulations, 1974. (S.I. No. 357 of 1974), and
- (c) Safety in Industry (Abrasive Wheels) Regulations, 1982. (S.I. No. 30 of 1982).
