DUBLIN CITY COUNCIL-INTOXICATING LIQUOR  
BYE LAWS 2008

Dublin City Council approved the adoption of revised Intoxicating Liquor Bye-Laws made under part 19 of the Local Government Act 2001 at the meeting of Dublin City Council on 1st September, 2008.

The revised Bye-Laws made under the Local Government Act 2001 prohibit the consumption of intoxicating liquor on the streets of Dublin and in public places, and allow for the confiscation of alcohol from persons engaged in public consumption of alcohol. They also provide for a fixed payment notice of €75 which must be paid within 21 days of the date of the notice in order to avoid prosecution and a fine of up to €1,900 on conviction in a Court of Law.

The new bye laws shall come into force on the 1st October, 2008.

These bye-laws may be inspected during ordinary office hours at the offices of Dublin City Council, Culture Recreation & Amenity Department, Block 4, Ground Floor, Civic Offices, Wood Quay, Dublin 8.

A copy of the draft bye-laws will be made available free of charge to any person applying for it.
